APA – The Engineered Wood Association is a widely recognized, ISO accredited organization with a long-standing role in conducting product testing and providing inspection, evaluation and certification services.

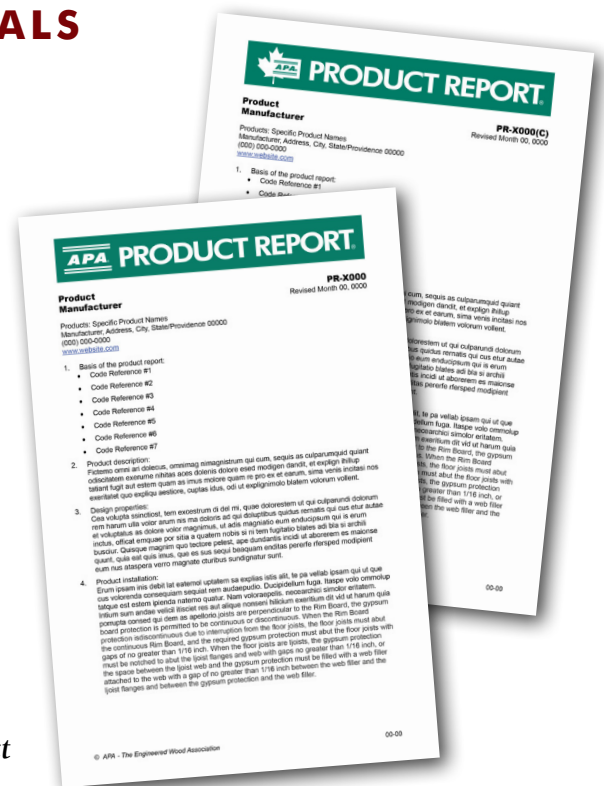
APA Product Reports® signify the product's compliance with the relevant provisions in the model building code. These reports:
